Calls will connect you to the police, fire services and ambulance. If an ambulance transports you to a hospital, then you may be charged a fee (\$250-\$385)	
211	211	24 hours a day/ 7 days a week	211 is a free, confidential service that provides information and referrals to a wide range of community, social, health and government services. This service can help you respond to your basic needs (food, clothing, shelter, and financial support), employment resources, parenting support, counselling/support groups, health care, legal service) Available in 170 languages, including Ukrainian and Russian
