Typical Costs Associated with Purchasing and Operating a Vehicle

Question: What are the typical costs associated with purchasing a vehicle?

Answer: The cost associated with purchasing a preowned vehicle varies, because this will largely depend on the customer's requirements.

- Regular inventory of pre-owned vehicles has prices ranging from as low as \$9,999 to \$57,000. This price range would be for a small car, SUVs or up to a sevenpassenger vehicle.
- You can also anticipate that interest charges will range from as low as 2.99% to 8.99% depending on the lender.
- You can also anticipate other mandatory fees, taxes, and expenses such as (1) Sales Administration \$899.95, (2) AMVIC \$6.95 and GST (5% of the cost of the vehicle), and (3) vehicle insurance.
- You should have a monthly budget for purchase of petrol (gasoline).
- You must also budget for other optional expenses, such as warranty packages and maintenance costs which can range from \$1295 up to \$5500.
- You must have vehicle insurance because this is mandatory in Canada for all vehicles.

 - Once you receive your Alberta personal health card, you can apply to receive additional health benefits that includes on-going coverage for prescription drugs, essential over-the-counter medications, eye exams and glasses, dental care, essential diabetic supplies and emergency ambulance services.
 - 2. Ukrainian evacuees will receive an Alberta Health Benefits (Ukrainian Evacuee) application form in the mail after they receive their Alberta personal health card. Complete this form and mail it using the preaddressed envelope provided (registries cannot accept this form) or fax it to the number below.



 - ii. Alberta Heath Card: This is needed to access health services

 - Ukrainians, and their families currently in Canada can apply to extend their stay for up to 3 years with the CUAET. This includes the temporary resident (visitor) status, work and study permits, and allows people to leave and return to Canada





at any time while their visa is valid. School aged children will be eligible to attend elementary and secondary school during this time.

Eligibility:

A status document with text stating "CUAET" directly on the visitor record, study permit, work **permit or temporary resident permit status document**

OR

Proof they are a Ukrainian national OR the dependent* of a Ukrainian temporary resident, such as a:

- a. Ukrainian passport, OR
- b. Document demonstrating that they are the dependent to a Ukrainian temporary resident

A <u>Dependent</u> is defined as: a spouse or common-law partner; their dependent child; the dependent child of their spouse/common-law partner; a dependent child of their dependent child. The dependent can be of any nationality.

AND A temporary resident status document, such as a:

- a. Work Permit
- b. Study Permit
- c. Visitor Record, or
- d. Temporary Resident Permit



Alberta Advantage Immigration Program
Overview

The Alberta Advantage Immigration Program (AAIP), formerly the Alberta Immigrant Nominee Program, is an economic immigration program that nominates people for permanent residence in Alberta. Nominees must have skills to fill job shortages or be planning to buy or start a business in Alberta. They must also be able to provide for their families. The program is run by the governments of Alberta and Canada.

If you are nominated through the program, you may apply for permanent residence status together with your spouse or common-law partner, and dependent children.

Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada manages applications for permanent residence. The federal government also makes final decisions on these applications.

Children's Services

Is expanding the child care subsidy eligibility criteria to include people who claim refugee status after arrival and temporary residents with a work permit. Previously, one of the applicants OR the child had to be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident. This change ensures that if the child requiring care or the applicants are neither Canadian citizens nor permanent residents but at least one of the applicants are a temporary resident with a work permit or are awaiting a refugee claimant decision, the family is better able to access affordable, quality licensed child care.

Effective August 1, 2022, parents/guardians who meet the expanded citizen/immigration status and other eligibility criteria with children 12 years old and not yet in grade 7 attending a licensed child care program can apply for child care subsidy. This change does not impact access to affordability grants. All non-permanent resident children enrolled in a licensed child care will continue to be eligible for the affordability grant reductions.
